



## Pandemic Re-Opening Policies and Procedures

This plan may be amended at any time based on the recommendations from public health, local, or government officials.

1. Any guest who has had a fever, cough or other symptoms of COVID19 within the last 24 hours should reschedule their visit.
2. Staff may ask any guest to reschedule if persistent symptoms including excessive coughing, sneezing, rash are observed.
3. All ticketing and payment for entrance is online on our website.
4. Reserved 2-hour session ticketing with 20 guests per session.
5. Guests are asked to wait outside building, 6 ft apart following visual staging when waiting for session to begin.
6. **No** outside food or drink.
7. All guests will use Hand sanitizer prior to entering and wash hands after entering.
8. **All guests over the age of 3 years must wear a mask. All employees wear masks.**
9. No large group events at this time.
10. Bins have been added around the museum for contaminated toys.
11. Individual art and makerspace projects are available for checkout.
12. Tissues, disinfectant wipes, and hand sanitizer are provided throughout museum.
13. **Summer Camp** is conducted as private event. See website for more information.
14. **All birthday parties are private** with a 10 child limit and can be booked as a venue buyout.
15. **All field trips are private.** Please call for registration information.
16. Gift shop items are behind the counter and online for purchase.
17. One-way direction of moving through the museum has been established.
18. Regular cleaning protocol with CDC approved cleaning products has been established.
19. The museum will close for 1 hour cleaning between sessions with small items replaced each session.

Phase I (4 weeks) - Beginning June 17<sup>th</sup>

1. Open 4 days/week for general public sessions (Wed/Fri/Sat/Sun)
2. No groups larger than 6 people.

Phase 2 (4 weeks) – Beginning July 13<sup>th</sup>

1. Open 5 days/week for general public sessions. (Mon/Wed/Fri/Sat/Sun)
2. No groups larger than 8 people

Phase 3 (4 weeks) – Beginning August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020

1. Open 7 days/week for general public sessions.

2. No groups larger than 8 people
